At 11 a.m. on Friday April 27, the Niagara District Council of Women will be planting a Sassafras Tree in Malcolmson Eco-Park to commemorate our 100th Anniversary and honour our founding president Mary Malcolmson.

The park is named after Mary Malcolmson, who also started the first Girl Guide unit in Canada in St. Catharines.

A dedication plaque will be placed with the tree.

Malcolmson Eco Park is located on Lakeshore Road at the north end of Niagara Street, west of Lock 1 of the Welland Canal. The ceremony will take place in the park near Lakeshore Road just east of the "Welcome to St. Catharines" sign.
